# Introduction

After a period of inactivity CADAP elected a new Director last August 2015. Initial activities included the reorganization of the webpage, designation of officers, organization of tournaments and multiple activities in discussion with the delegates conforming zone 2.

It was felt important to address the level of interest in the membership by conducting a survey.

## CADAP General Survey

Using the ICCF mail system, 1,077 registered CADAP members were contacted and asked to answer a SurveyMonkey questionnaire. Since our account is free we were only able to quantify the first 100 responses. The answers were not always exclusive.

  - c. 10 to 19 USD (38.04%)
  - d. 20 or more USD (9.78%)
- 3. What would be the lowest cash prize that you would be willing to accept?
  - a. Under 100 USD (34.09%)
  - b. 100 to 299 USD (29.55%)
  - c. 300 to 499 USD (18.18%)
  - d. 500 to 1000 USD (10.23%)
  - e. More than 1000 USD (7.95%)
- 4. Do you have a Paypal account?
  - a. Yes (53.54%)
  - b. No (46.46%)

CADAP Master qualification criteria

- 11- to 13-player groups
- Winner of a Higher Class group
- ICCF rating between 2150-2299
- Unrated players when nominated by their federation but with never more than 25% unrated players per group
- Winner will obtain a norm towards the CADAP Master title, two norms required for the Title

Winner will qualify to the CADAP Grandmaster tournament

#### CADAP Grandmaster

Registration still open for the first events in this category.

CADAP is requesting that Congress approves norms in these events

### CADAP Grandmaster qualification criteria

- 11- to 13-player groups
- ICCF or FIDE rating of 2300 or higher
- Top 3 placings in their National Championship Final
- Winners of a CADAP Master event
- No more than 25% unrated players allowed per group
- Winner will obtain a norm towards the CADAP Grandmaster title, two norms required to award title

### **Interzonal Events**

CADAP nominated 27 players to the Preliminaries of the Second Individual Interzonal Tournament.

#### Panamerican Events

The 11<sup>th</sup> Panamerican Team Championship will be organized in March 2017, for more details see tournament calendar.

The First Panamerican Individual Championship was organized in 2013, see Carlos Cranbourne's report to Congress for more details and Congress approval. The Semifinals of this event started in July 2015.

The Preliminaries of the Second Panamerican Individual Championship will start in July 2017.

LIPEAD provided funds to pay for 3 years of webhosting and domains for CADAP since we started out without any money. LIPEAD also paid for 1 year of SSL service and other software expense.

GoDaddy provides the webhosting, domains and SSL. 179.64 for 3 years until 2018. Domains 4 .com, .net, .info, .net 103.64 per year, until 10/4/2018, ssl 139.98 per year, 1 year paid.

The website uses Wordpress, LIPEAD purchased the license for the theme: Magazine Premium.

There are 87 users registered on the website, 7 of them with the author role.

A total of 20,332 visits with an average of 150 per day and a maximum of 515 visits in a single day.

# Finance Report

## Payment methods accepted from players

## Paypal

When CADAP restarted operations we opened a Paypal account <a href="mailto:glio@outlook.com">glio@outlook.com</a>. The website was setup to accept Paypal payments. Paypal discriminatory policies against users from Cuba led to a temporary hold of our funds until their investigation was finished. During the investigation CADAP opened a second Paypal account <a href="mailto:directorcadap@gmail.com">directorcadap@gmail.com</a>. Paypal requested that CADAP either stopped using Paypal in our website or provided a different payment method for players from Cuba. We decided to stop using Paypal in our website last February 2016.

## Credit or debit cards via Stripe

CADAP opened an account with Stripe and started accepting credit and debit card payments in our website since April 2016. The account is connected with a bank account we created in Lamar, Colorado where funds get transferred within days.

CADAP expenses refer to website maintenance costs, software and utilities purchased as well as payments to ICCF.
