1. Tournaments

Petr Boukal was one of the best Czech correspondence chess players, and also a very strong over-the-board player. Reached the 3rd place in the final of the 28th World Championship, where he reached his GM title. He was a member of the Czech CCA Executive Board. Until his sudden death he administered the Correspondence Chess column in the prestigious chess magazine Československý šach.

Petr was not only a strong chess player, chess publicist and active officer, but above all a fine man and friend. Czech CCA decided to honour his memory with a strong international category 14 tournament.
