Career summary:

After qualifying as a Chartered Accountant in 1965, I joined Price Waterhouse in their Cardiff and later London offices, concentrating on audit work. Leaving in 1979, I moved into the industrial sphere, initally taking leading roles in IT installation projects, and then moving onto company secretarial roles and financial directorships. During 1995-1998, I was managing (and financial) director of a small company manufacturing railway equipment for World Bank projects throughout Africa.



In 1999 I accepted a position as financial controller in the S Wales operation of a Belgian-based multi-national.
