No additional entry fees are levied above the membership fee required to be a member of NATCOR, and there is no cash prize.

Overall the tournament is organised into divisions where members play one game against each opponent in their division, with as close to an equal number of games played as black or white depending on numbers in their division. At the end of the tournament the winner of the 'Premier Division' is crowned the 'Champion of NATCOR' for that season and wins a year's free membership to the club. The top two players in each division (except the 'Premier') are promoted to the division above (e.g. 1<sup>st</sup> Division is promoted to the 'Premier'), and the bottom two players are relegated to the division below (e.g. 1<sup>st</sup> Division to 2<sup>nd</sup> Division).
